What is KinderVision?

KinderVision is an educational program which disseminates valuable safety information to families in a variety of ways. At KV Kids events, participating families are given a free KinderVision video in English or Spanish containing a special message narrated by law enforcement which provides critical safety information for the protection of their children. In the KinderVision video, families are advised of the circumstances to avoid and the children are taught what to do if confronted. Each child is videotaped on the end of the KinderVision safety video to insure repeat viewing. Local and state law enforcement and local fire departments are invited to attend. Law Enforcement explorers are used when available.

Children are our most precious blessing. Protecting them is our most significant responsibility.

The KinderVision video is designed for ongoing educational use within the home and enables parents to periodically instruct their children in a relaxed family setting on ways to prevent abduction. Through the use of child actors and the costumed character, KindiBear, the educational segment demonstrates techniques and presents information in such a way that small children can easily understand.
